Carolyn Gough led discussion of fundraising for the school. Can drive is finishing up. Members should start thinking of who to sponsor for Sub for Santa. We will think of Jordan Education Foundation partner to possibly pair with or to come up with a fundraiser to run on our own. One idea was a walk or run where businesses donate per lap. Carolyn added that our general budget was low and we would like to have a fundraiser to bolster this fund.

Carolyn passed out data review sheets to analyze student progress and benchmarks. We reviewed Language Arts, Math, and Science CRT scores over the past years with a focus on 2012 scores. We will use this data to help decide school goals and focus points for instruction.

Carolyn explained the budget revision that two school-aide positions had been eliminated from trust lands. That money will help decrease the budget deficit and to provide professional development for teachers. Committee members signed the budget revision.
