1. Safe Walking Route: The proposal for the 2013-2014 safe walking route was presented and discussed.
2. School Safety Issues: The district has provided professional development in the safety of all Jordan School District buildings. A thorough checklist was provided to each school that assessed all areas of safety in the building. All visitors will be asked to check into the main office, show identification and get a visitors badge in order to access the building. A Skylert will be sent out to the community to educate them in this process.
3. School Land Trust: The plan for 2012-2013 was discussed and reviewed. Data evidence from Language Arts CRT's was provided which assesses the goal for Language Arts. The data showed growth in the 2011-2012 school year. The SRI average scores made growth from 50.8 to 51.3 from the 2010-2011 to the 2011-2012 school year. The DWA scores showed growth from 20.8 to 22.8 from the 2010-2011 to the 2011-2012 school year. The reading goal was met. The math data was reviewed and discussed. The math CRT data showed a growth in the scores during the 2011-2012 school year. The math goal was met. Data evidence for Science was reviewed and discussed. The goal for Science was met. The proposal for the 2013-2014 school year was presented, discussed and approved.
