C. Land Trust Update

- 1. Committee looked at the 2021 test scores data
 - a. Q: Is there something we can do to help our math scores?
 - b. Ideas
 - i. Perhaps a math aide?
 - ii. TA interventions?
 - iii. Re-visit Flex?
 - iv. Online learning (now that we know how to do it properly)
 - v. Pay teachers to stay later
- 2. Chromebook discussion
 - a. Should we continue the 1:1 ratio?
 - i. Chromebooks decrease need for textbooks
 - ii. Class fees are going away
 - iii. Chromebooks have a three-year life span
 - iv. Math department already dropped their request for touch screen machines
 - v. Difficult to go backwards at this point
 - b. Touch screen machines are \$370 each
 - c. Non-touch screen machines are \$214 each
 - d. We have 357 incoming 7th graders if we order 400, we need \$83,000
 - e. We may need to split the cost of new chromebooks between two budgets.

Jim will get the proposed Land Trust Budget to this committee prior to March 17th.

D. COVID update - discussion about teacher absences and the dearth of substitutes. Things were much worse before Christmas break but have leveled off.

- E. Living Planet Aquarium field trip discussion
 - 1. Trip was over too long a time period
 - 2. There was no place for the students to eat their lunches
 - 3. Parent chaperones were assigned to an area instead of to a group of students
 - 4. Principal's plan to address issue:
 - a. Science team meeting in the morning
 - b. Split the 7th grade group's trip into AM and PM
 - c. Investigate other venues
- F. Student Groups Update Middle School clubs have been approved by the District. We currently have three.
- G. Added item: The Jordan School Board is going to re-district and we need pro-teacher to run. March 1 is the deadline to file. They are adding a new seat.
