Call to Order:

- Approve October Meeting Minutes

Items

- Counseling Center Update
 - Finished the 3-year required needs assessment to find gaps and means to adjust the needs in the counseling center
 - Registration is over
 - 6th→7th 7th Grade Orientation Night was successful
 - 7th→ to 8th and 8th → 9th graders' class presentations for registration
 - 9th graders had a mini assembly with MRHS
 - April 20th: Arena Scheduling lesson
 - May 27th: 9th Grade Awards
- Topics
 - Safe Walking Routes
 - The question posed whether there were any routes crossing the Mt. View Corridor. Students who live in the Monarch Meadows complex are currently provided a courtesy shuttle, but a Safe Walking Route is in place along 13400.
 - Safe Walking Routes do not need to be in place for students who live North of 13400. However, many students will be attending next year on a permit. A crossing guard will not be in place
 - Jarom Airhart oversees our Safe Walking Routes and has received updates from Riverton City.
 - UDOT is overseeing the bridge construction. The bridge will be constructed next year around this time.
 - The city would like the land to the west, behind the school, which is being developed, and they would like an access point on the west
 - This sounds contrary to the information that is being communicated from the state legislatures direction about fencing

- 4000 W Sidewalk on the east side of the road will be installed.

- 2025-2026 TSSA Plan Update
- 2025-2026 LAND Trust Plan Update
 - Close to meeting the requirements of 10% spending threshold.
- 2026-2027 TSSA Plan DRAFT
 - Professional development is a higher priority through this plan, rather than through the LAND Trust Plan
 - Draft due to the district at the end of March.
 - The district sets the overall goals. School initiatives align with the district goals.
 - Questions about how the data collected from Swivl M2 would be regulated and collected. The district's Digital Teaching and Learning team will develop protocols for this technology.
- 2026-2027 LAND Trust Plan DRAFT (Approval Needed) School Information
 - Goal 1: Increase quarter credits recovered by 9th graders through credit recovery measures.
 - Last year's data indicate 8 quarters of credits been remediated.
 - Credit recovery course teachers report that only the 1st- and 2nd-quarter classes. Teachers report that students who remediated courses for the 1st- and 2nd-quarter no longer fail courses during the 3rd- and 4th-quarters.
 - Previous plans to pay for "packets" to remediate classes were not being utilized last year.
 - JLC will offer remediation packets for Jordan School District Students
 - In addition to the Outline Action Plans
 - SHARES
 - Math Lab
 - ELD Class
 - Suggested adding additional data to support the narrative
 - Goal 2: Increase proficiency to 50% on end of the end-of-year testing
 - Overall growth has a positive trend
 - Aides are available to support teachers (SPED and ML aides) as needed.
 - Funding Change Allocation
 - Changes in funding will need to be approved by the committee. Priorities are listed on the plan.
